New employees and contract personnel are subject to mandatory safety orientation prior to commencing work,

We emphasize training within our workforce and promote communication on safety through regular safety meetings.

Jimbob Rentals (2000) Ltd. is committed to controlling losses to our workers and/or equipment and the general public. This is accomplished by identification of hazards and eliminating the unsafe condition or act before it manifests into an accident/incident. All equipment is properly maintained so as to reduce risk of injury and property damage. According to established schedules our company employees and qualified personnel carry out all preventative maintenance and conduct regular inspections of our facilities.

However should an incident/near miss occur it is Jimbob Rentals (2000) Ltd. policy that all incidents, resulting in or potentially resulting in injury or property damage, be documented through well- developed incident/accident reporting and must be thoroughly investigated to determine the cause so appropriate actions can be taken to prevent reoccurrence.

Jimbob Rentals (2000) Ltd. is committed to continuously monitoring and upgrading our safety program by reviewing and updating safety policies, safe job procedures & practices and by maintaining equipment to the highest standards to help ensure the right to a safe working environment for all.
